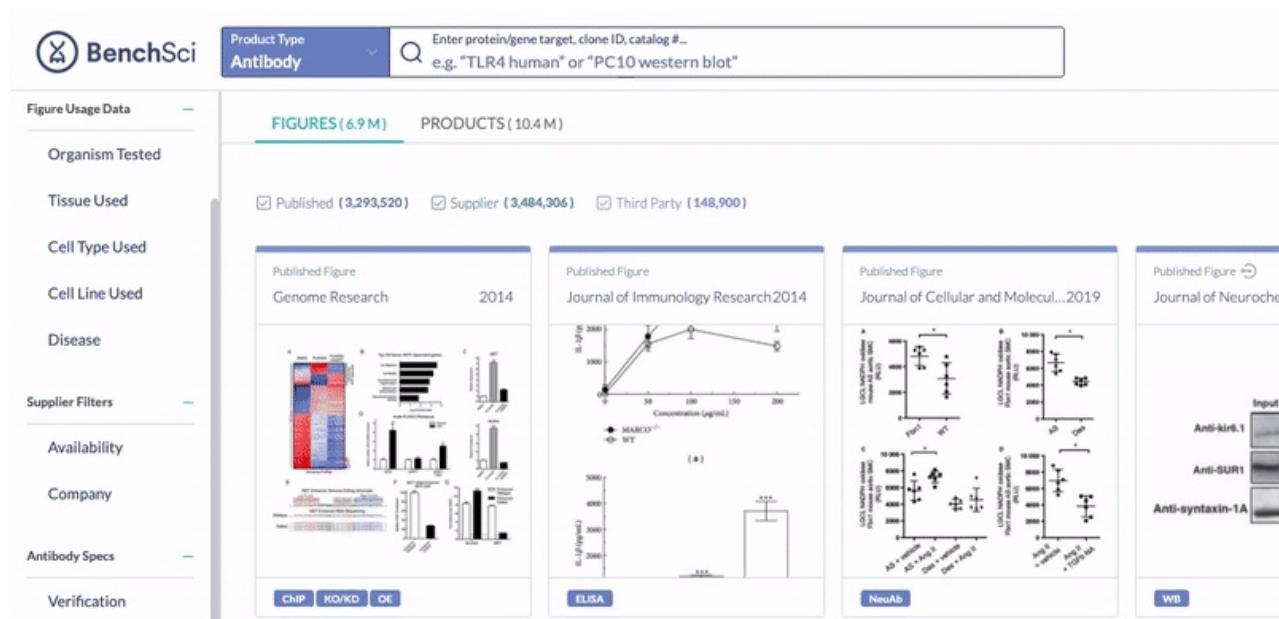


Re-visiting recent and saved searches

Planning your next experiments and finding appropriate reagents and model systems can be an iterative process. To help you, clicking into an empty search bar shows you a list of your most recent 15 searches that you can easily rerun. This can ease navigating our app when you're comparing different targets and/or experimental contexts for your research. You can curate this list by removing a search by clicking the **X**.





For search queries you run often, you have the option to explicitly save your search and revisit it on the *saved searches* tab of your **Profile**.
